

## Road Driving with Mr. Snow

### INSTRUCTIONS:

Hello students, Please follow the following instructions to get set up.

Note: Those students who have an EXPIRED permit either need to go to the DLD and renew your "Temporary Learner Driving Permit" or simply need to produce an updated copy for me to have. As soon as you take care of this item you can follow the instructions below and schedule your driving with Mr. Snow. You should NOT create your Moneo Drivers Account until after you have updated your permit.

### **Road Driving Instructions:**

1. First you will need to create a "Moneo Drive Account" this will enable you to schedule your driving time and dates with Mr. Snow. You can schedule Two Drives a week! Please follow the account registration instruction sheet provided. Have your parent or legal guardian sign at the bottom of the page and detach the permission slip and bring it to me on your first drive. I will also expect you to have your Temp. Learners Permit with you as well.
2. After you have created your "**Moneo Driver Account**" Using your name and password, log in and locate "**Stansbury road driving with Mr. Snow**" go to the calendar icon and schedule your driving. The dates will appear. We need Two students to register for the same time slot for each day. The first available drive time will likely be Friday January 6th. Right after school. I will always meet you at the LDS. Seminary building across from the Stansbury High School!
3. In order to establish a communication system, you will also need to sign up for updates for road driving using Remind 101. This is how I communicate with you. You may be able to contact me through this same avenue or text my phone. Please register before you expect to drive with me. Register this week prior to Friday!
4. Another way to contact me is by my E-mail [dsnow@tooeleschools.org](mailto:dsnow@tooeleschools.org) if you ever expect to cancel a road drive you must contact me a **full 24hrs in advance** or you will be placed once again at the bottom of the driving list, as we have a large back log of students waiting to drive.
