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Course Description:

*United States History II addresses the making of modern America. We highlight the events and issues in United States history from the late Industrial Revolution to modern times. Topics include, but are not limited to, the Industrial Revolution, the Progressive movement, imperialism, foreign affairs, the World Wars, the Great Depression, the Cold War, the civil rights movements, the rise of terrorism, and modern social and political history. **This course is required for graduation from Grantsville High School.***

Course Standards:

Classroom objectives as designed by the Utah State Office of Education will be posted on the board for students to reference. This course will reflect the state implementation of the Utah Common Core.

Course Requirements:

- **Attendance:** Students are expected to attend school regularly, be on time, and be prepared to learn.
- **Assignments:** All assignments will be given in class. Students should also expect to complete readings, reflective writings, and take part in roleplay simulations. If students do not finish their assignments in class they can also be accessed at our class website www.mrsnow.org. Students who miss a class must consult with Mr. Snow about assignment due dates and any potential accommodations related to the assignments missed.
- **Citizenship & Behavior:** This grade is based on behavior, class participation, and attendance. Students will be considered tardy if they are not in their seat ready to work when the bell rings. **Attendance can affect citizenship grades.** Students that disrupt the learning environment will be asked to leave and any defiant behavior can result in a referral to administration. NOTE: ***This includes the improper use of Cell Phone Texting during class.***
- **Classroom Community:** We will place emphasis on respecting others and their personal opinions, learning abilities, ethnicity, and faith. A united effort to create a cooperative learning environment will be expected and promoted. We will help one another create a sense of belonging, and we will go the extra mile to help everyone succeed academically.
Note: We will also emphasize a spirit of patriotism and respect for our nation and the flag. We may have visitors who have served in the military visit our class on special occasions. **CELL PHONES IN CLASS? Cell Phones are to be used ONLY AS FOR STUDY AIDS or FOR USE AS AUTHORIZED BY THE TEACHER – TEXTING IS NOT APPROPRIATE IN THE CLASSROOM. 5% CELL PHONE GRADE POINTS WILL BE ADDED OR DEDUCTED Weekly BASED UPON THIS CLASSROOM PERFORMANCE STANDARD.**

Grading and Assessment Procedures:

- Assignments are given in class and points are awarded for completing these assignments. Students may find more information about the assignments on our class website. **Additionally, 50% of student grades will be determined by note taking, benchmark tests, Self-grading rubrics, and Weekly *Cell Phone Vacation pts!***
- Benchmark exams will be given to ensure students are meeting learning goals. **Students must pass the benchmark exams with a 75 % or higher score to be considered proficient in the tested subject area.**
- Extra Credit options are applicable only after all assignments have been completed and turned in!

Make Up/Late Work
